ALPE ADRIA MOTOCROSS CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS 2024



1. GENERAL

Alpe Adria Motorcycle Union (AAMU) organizes the Open Alpe Adria Motocross Championships 2023 (AAMXC) in accordance with the regulations of FIM, FIME and AAMU.

AAMXC 2023 will be held through at least 3 races according to the official Calendar which is an integral part of this Regulations.

In addition to the AAMXC race, race organizers (FMNR) can also combined this races with other Championships - Cups.

1.1. Participants

AAMXC is Open.

All Riders of any FMNs, with valid FMN licenses and starting permissions.

1.2. Classes

- MX 50 (no for standing of nations)
- MX 65
- MX 85
- MX 1
- MX 2

2. RULES AND PROCEDURES

FIM, AAMU rules and S.R.s

2.1. Supplementary regulations

Supplementary regulations will be drafted by the organizer and FMN, as well as sent for AAMU approval at least 30 days before the race.

The form of the Supplementary regulations will be made by the AAMU (Motocross Commission).

2.2. Entries, registration and technical control

2.5. Qualifications

According to S.R.s

In the event that the number of registered riders in one class is greater than 40, priority is given to the riders who achieved a better result in the qualifications, regardless of whether they are competing in the AAMXC or another championship.

2.6. Standings

For an individual standing, riders receive points for each run according to the following:

RANK	1.	2.	3.	4.	5.	6.	7.	8.	9.	10.	11.	12.	13.	14.	15.	16.	17.	18.	19.	20.
POINTS	25	22	20	18	16	15	14	13	12	11	10	9	8	7	6	5	4	3	2	1

For the standing of nations, the 3 best placed riders of one nation from any class (except MX 50) are included in scoring.

Verification of the overall standing in AAMXC 2023 is the responsibility of the AAMU Motocross Commission.

In case 2 riders or nations have the same number of points at the end of the Championship, the rider or nation that achieves better results in the last race of the Championship will be better.

3. TECHNICAL RULES

FIM MX Technical rules.

3.1. Starting numbers

In case two riders in the same class have the same start numbers, this problem will be solved by compromise by the organizer.

Priority is given to riders of national championships.

4. OFFICIALS

FIM, AAMU rules and S.R.

The AAMU will designate a Delegate and AAMU steward for each race (Motocross Commission).

The costs of officials - according to the AAMU rules.

6. MISCELLANEOUS

Interpretation of the rules is the responsibility of the AAMU Motocross Commission.
Prizes for the first 3 places per class in the individual standings and the standing of nations will be awarded by the organizer in each individual race.
Prizes for general standings of the Championship will be awarded by AAMU.
AAMU can hire the promoter for AAMXC 2024.
